Our title character gets roped into joining Father Nicholas's (Tongayi Chirisa) soccer team in the dad-themed opener and, in the follow-up episode the same night, makes a grave social-media faux pas. Look for cameos from Jerry Seinfeld and Raven-Symoné and the return of Macaulay Culkin! Gaffigan shares what else is on his plate in Season 2.

How is this season different from the first? Jeannie [Gaffigan's wife and fellow executive producer] and I were really treating every episode like it's the last one we're ever going to do, and we're making a point of being bold. It's kind of like the *Titanic* is always going down, so if you're going to have the band play a song, have them play your favorite song—do you know what I mean?

There's a jail scene coming up. Did your character finally get arrested for taking the trash out in his boxers? [Laughs] No, no, it has to do with social media and outrage. I had this tweet [about manicures] a long time ago that got me in trouble. It's inspired a bit from my life, but it totally goes in a different direction.

How do the off-screen Gaffigans celebrate Father's Day? Usually at a family reunion. My kids are young, so they usually give me a drawing and then we move on. It's also one of my sons' birthdays. I'm such a family comic. I even had a kid born on Father's Day.

CASUAL'S VINCENT KARTHEISER

HE PLAYS Jordan, the venture capitalist who swoops in to help Alex (Tommy Dewey) spiff up his dating website. The issue: They find out their love lives have some overlap. "It's something they probably would have never found out," Kartheiser says. "Jordan is just trying to fit in without causing too many waves. He's all about being the new-age, hip boss. Alex is forced to attend a social engagement at his house and it's beyond saying that tragedy ensues."

WHERE YOU'VE SEEN HIM BEFORE He freaked the wits out of *Angel* fans as the titular character's superhuman son in the early aughts, but Kartheiser is best known for playing unforgettably smarmy adman Pete Campbell on *Mad Men*. "I've been offered a lot of Pete-type roles since," he says, "but that's the nature of the industry. Even Jordan has some connection to Pete, and it's good. It's a position the audience is familiar with when it comes to me."

WHY WE LOVE HIM Kartheiser knows the best way to make a regular guy like Jordan funny is to not *make* him funny at all. "That would be a big mistake, at least for someone like me," the actor says. "I just try to allow the good writing and Tommy to be the comic elements."

CAT'S IN THE CRADLE Before moving in with wife Alexis Bledel (the pair welcomed their first child, a son, last fall), the Minnesota native and his Siamese cat Simon lived in a cabin in the Hollywood Hills that—at 580 square feet—was smaller than many New York City studios. "He didn't even have cat litter," Kartheiser says. "I would just take him outside to the woods." —*Aubry D'Arminio*
